
TIME LAPSE

Waititi finds creative and visually striking ways to show a passage of time in his time lapses. Pans, long takes, and 360 degree shots are some of the ways he executes time passing.

Wilderpeople contains a complicated 720-degree long take (the camera pans around the action twice) where characters pop in and out of frame on multiple occasions to suggest the passage of a much longer stretch of time.
